

Printing Digital Pictures with Windows XP

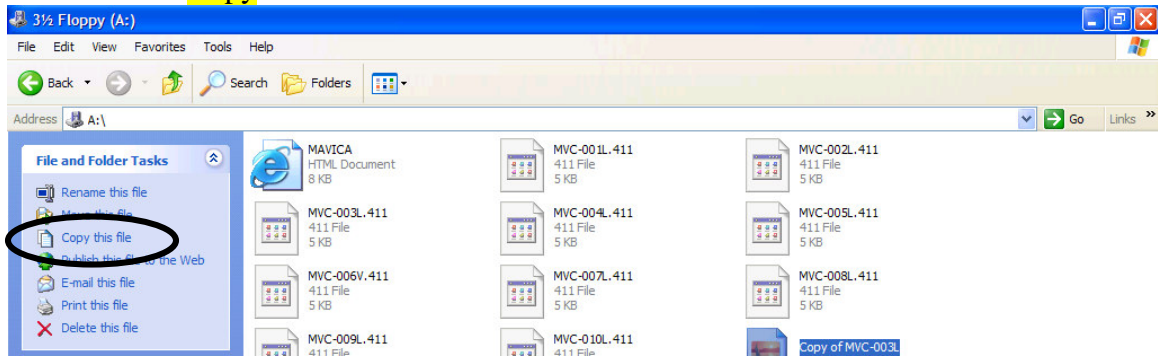

To print the pictures on your memory card without saving to your computer:

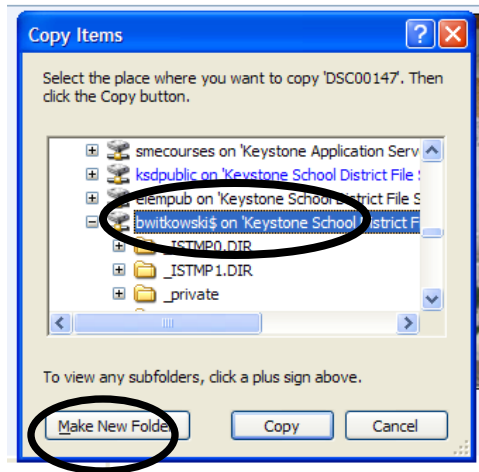
1. Double click on “My Computer.” (Or click on the Start button and then My Computer)
2. Double click on drive where your pictures are stored. (A: is for floppy drive, D: for CD drive, etc. The Card Reader could be E, F, G, or H . . .)
3. To see thumbnails of your pictures, click View—Thumbnails.
4. Click on the picture(s) you’d like to print. (Hold down CTRL and click to select multiple pictures.)
5. Click on “Print this picture.”
6. The Photo Printing Wizard will appear. Choose the size of prints you want, etc. Print!

To SAVE the pictures on your computer and then print them:

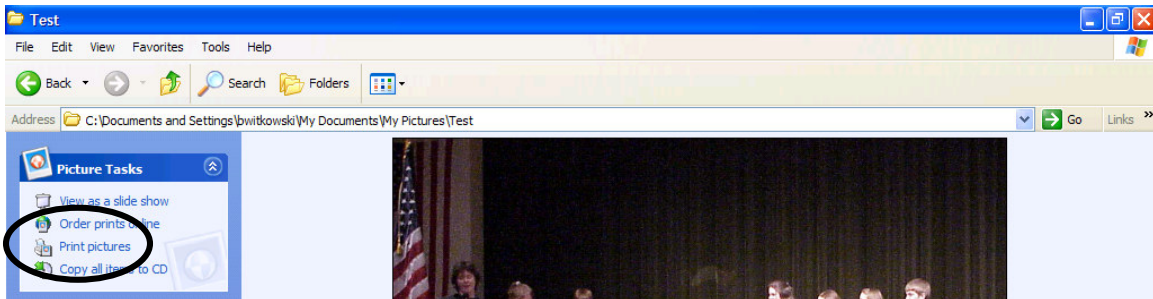
1. Double click on “My Computer.” (Or click on the Start button and then My Computer)
2. Double click on drive where your pictures are stored. (A: is for floppy drive, D: for CD drive, etc. The Card Reader could be E, F, G, or H . . .)
3. To see thumbnails of your pictures, click View—Thumbnails.
4. Rename the pictures you want to save or print. Right click on the picture, click Rename, and type a new unique name.
5. Click on the picture(s) you’d like to print. Hold down CTRL and click to select multiple pictures.
6. Click on “Copy this file.”



7. Move to a designated folder on your “T” drive. You can make other folders within your “T” drive to keep your pictures organized.



8. Now go to the folder on your T drive to work with your pictures. To access your T drive, double click on My Computer on your desktop, then on “T.”



9. To print pictures, click on the pictures you want to print. (Remember, CTRL + click to select multiples.)
10. Click on “Print the selected pictures.” The Photo Printing Wizard will appear. Choose the size of prints you want, etc. Print!
